However, in the Midterm and Promotion Assessments, students are assessed on all the main subjects, as well as the additional subjects. The aggregate percentage is calculated on the basis of the student's performance in the main subjects.

The Assessment scheme will have an 80 marks component for the Midterm and Annual Assessments in all scholastic subjects along with a 20 marks component for Internal Assessments.

The weightage of various Assessments is as follows:

- Midterm Assessment 50%
- Promotion Assessment 50%

DISCIPLINE
