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# SCHEME OF STUDIES

## SCHOLASTIC DOMAIN:

A student has to study the following subjects:

Main subjects	English, Hindi, Mathematics, Science, Social Science Third Language (French/German/Sanskrit) & Information Technology. Weightage for each subject is 100 and for the Third Language is 50.
Additional subjects	Art and Music

A student is assessed in the main subjects (Information Technology excluded) in EOT May and EOT November Assessments, which form part of the Internal Assessments. However, in the Mid Term and Promotion Assessments, students are assessed in the main subjects, as well as the additional subjects. The aggregate percentage is calculated on the basis of the student's performance in the main subjects.

The Assessment scheme will have an 80 marks component for the Mid Term and Annual Assessments in all scholastic subjects along with a 20 marks component for Internal Assessments.

The weightage of various Assessments is as follows:

- Mid Term Assessment – 50%
- Promotion Assessment – 50%
